SAFETY IDENTIFICATION CHECKS

This will comprise of spending time on your sites with the relevant managers and going through what their policies and procedures are regarding WHS. This will also include a walk through the site to inspect on any hazards and what control measures have been put in place. The audit process takes a day to complete and managers will need to make themselves available for the entire process. At the conclusion of the audit, a report will be drafted for your reference.

TEST AND TAGGING

This will involve checking all electrical equipment, including RCD's, with electrical testing equipment and placing a tag on the item to confirm that the item is serviceable.
